Context and objectives

An assessment of the STEREO program revealed that too often algorithms developed under the umbrella of STEREO projects, although published in A1 publications, are not or only very occasionally disseminated/used by other researchers within and outside the STEREO network.

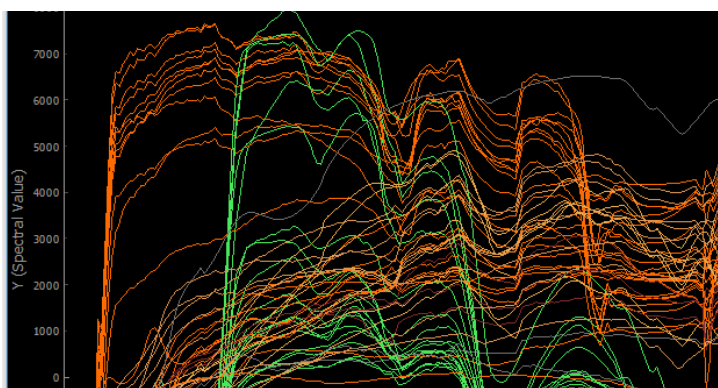
We wanted to realize a set of plugins for QGIS, based on BELSPO research, that appealed to a diverse user group (from student to expert) and to offer those tools alongside a user manual and exercises, all in a simple, standardized way.

Project outcome

The following tools have been developed:

- Tree Density Tool: Calculate the tree density of a given region, by moving a sliding window over a brightness image and detecting local maxima. <https://treedensitycalculator.readthedocs.io>
- Neural Network MLP Classifier: Supervised classification method for multi-band passive optical remote sensing data, based on the MLP (multi-layer perception) neural network classifier by scikit-learn. <https://mlp-image-classifier.readthedocs.io>
- Spectral Library Tool: Build, visualize and optimize spectral libraries. <https://spectral-libraries.readthedocs.io>
- MESMA: Multiple Endmember Spectral Mixture Analysis (MESMA), visualisation of results and other MESMA-related post-processing. <https://mesma.readthedocs.io>
- EOF-based Time Series Reconstructor: Image reconstructing algorithm based on EOFs (empirical orthogonal functions), designed specifically for oceanography. <https://eof-reconstructor.readthedocs.io>
- FORCE4Q: Visualize FORCE Level-2 outputs or Landsat/Sentinel2 Level-2A products in QGIS. It specifically makes use of FORCE's Higher Level Processing System for generating image composites and time series from multi-temporal Level 2 bottom of atmosphere surface reflectance imagery. <https://force4q.readthedocs.io>
