

 - Ongoing projects: 3














- Partnerships private companies and research laboratories
 - Ongoing projects: 5
 - Call for proposals SR5
 - ➤ closed: 16 April 2004
 - > 4 proposals
 - ➤ selection: 1 July 2004
 - > start of projects: autumn 2004







Status (continued)



- ➤ CASI-SWIR 2002 campaign
 - > 7 projects
 - results presented at the Bruges 2003 workshop
- ➤ CASI-ATM 2003 campaign
 - > ESA PRODEX funding
 - ▶ 7 projects











- ➤ HyMap 2004 campaign
 - ➤ Call for proposals closed: 27 February 2004
 - ▶ 12 proposals, probably 9 proposals selected
 - > Flight window: 24 May 27 June
